### Automobile Insurance Rate Board

The Honourable Iris Evans, Minister of Finance and Enterprise invites applications from individuals interested in serving on the Automobile Insurance Rate Board (AIRB).

The nine member AIRB was established in 2004 as part of the automobile insurance reforms to regulate rating programs of Alberta automobile insurers and to approve premiums that are fair and predictable for both consumers and insurers.

The AIRB derives its authority under sections 652 to 660.1 of the *Insurance Act*; and is responsible for setting premiums for compulsory automobile insurance coverage and for monitoring premiums applicable for optional auto insurance coverage such as collision and comprehensive. The Board is also responsible, in conjunction with the Superintendent of Insurance, for public information with respect to automobile insurance in Alberta. Significant past experience in the auto insurance industry and strong financial expertise will be considered an asset. Interpersonal abilities to deal effectively with other board members, previous board experience, business experience and demonstrated community service will be considered an asset. - Resume

Note: Applicants must currently be independent of any involvement in the auto insurance industry. A time commitment of approximately 1 day per month is required. Members are paid travel expenses and a per diem at the government set rate. Final candidates will be asked to undergo a security screening.
